- 2. The above-mentioned grant is subject to the under mentioned conditions:-
- [i] The grants-in-aid to the **57** Homes [**34** State Government run Observation/Children Homes and **23** NGO run Homes] which were getting financial assistance under the erstwhile scheme namely 'A Programme for Juvenile Justice' has been allowed as per the norms of the erstwhile scheme, 'A Programme for Juvenile Justice' in the current financial year. The old norms have been proposed keeping in mind that these projects are still running as per the specifications of erstwhile Juvenile Justice scheme and would require some time to upgrade themselves to the criterion laid down under ICPS. No fund for construction/ maintenance of additional homes have been allowed during the current financial year of 2009-10.

- [11] The recurring grants-in-aid for 10 Open Shelters is allowed as per the norms of the scheme 'An Integrated Programme for Street Children' during the current financial year of 2009-10 keeping in mind that these projects are still running as per the specifications of erstwhile scheme and would require some time to upgrade themselves to the criterion laid down under ICPS. However, the State Government will visit and satisfy themselves that the organizations are implementing the project satisfactorily before release of grant to these organizations.
- The grants-in-aid for full year to the 8 existing Specialised Adoption Agency [SAA] is [iii] allowed as per the norms of the erstwhile Shishu Greh Scheme.
- The Government of Gujarat shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of [iv] accounts together with the necessary utilization certificates in respect of the above grant and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2009-10.
- The State Government should certify that the maintenance grants in respect of [V] voluntary organizations are approved by the State Government as required under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2000 as amended in 2006.
- That no further grant will be released till the utilization certificate and the audited [vi] statements of accounts towards grant already released are furnished to this Ministry.
- The above grants-in-aid will be released to the Government of Gujarat through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur Branch, Nagpur.
- The expenditure involved is debitable to Major Head 3601; Grants-in-aid to State Government; 04-Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes; 358-Social Welfare - Child Welfare; 07-Integrated Child Protection Scheme[ICPS]; 07.0031 -Grants-in-aid; Demand No.104, Ministry of Women and Child Development for the year 2009-10(Plan).
