- 2. The above-mentioned grant is subject to the under mentioned conditions:-
- [i] The grants-in-aid to the **9** Homes [**5** State Government run Homes and **4** NGO run Homes] which were getting financial assistance under the erstwhile scheme namely 'A Programme for Juvenile Justice' has been allowed as per the norms of the erstwhile scheme, 'A Programme for Juvenile Justice' in the current financial year. The old norms have been proposed keeping in mind that these projects are still running as per the specifications of erstwhile Juvenile Justice scheme and would require some time to upgrade themselves to the criterion laid down under ICPS. No funds for construction/ maintenance of additional homes have been allowed during the current financial year of 2009-10.
- [ii] Grants-in-aid to the existing Specialized Adoption Agency [SAA] is allowed as per the norms of the erstwhile scheme of Scheme for Assistance to Homes to Promote Incountry Adoption'
- [iii] The Government of Haryana shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary utilization certificates in respect of the above grant and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2009-10.
- [iv] The State Government should certify that the maintenance grants in respect of voluntary organizations are approved by the State Government as required under the Juvenile Justice (Care and protection of Children) Act, 2000.
- [v] That no further grant will be released till the utilization certificate and the audited statements of accounts towards grant already released are furnished to this Ministry.
