

2. The above-mentioned grant is subject to the under mentioned conditions:-

- [i] **As approved by PAB** all recurring grants for have been approved for 6 months including salaries of appointed staff only for SPSU, of which grants for 3 months and 17 days (from 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2012 to March, 2013) has been provided as per ICPS norms in the current year. The balance grants would be released in the beginning of 2013-14. Non-recurring grant has already been provided to the State.
- [ii] **As approved by PAB** recurring grant have been provided for 6 months (October 2012 to March 2013) for SCPS as per ICPS norms except for the staff salary. Non-recurring grant has already been provided to the State. No grants were approved for innovative project as the same was not requested by the State Govt.
- [iii] **As approved by PAB** recurring grants, including staff salary for staff already appointed, except DCPO, for 6 months (October 2012 to March 2013) have been provided for 16 DCPUs as per ICPS norms. The State has not requested any grant under Sponsorship, Foster care and After care Programme. Non-recurring grant has already been provided to the State.
- [iv] **As approved by PAB** all recurring grants for have been approved for 6 months including salaries of appointed staff only for SARA, of which grants for 3 months and 17 days (from 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2012 to March, 2013) has been provided as per ICPS norms in the current year. The balance grants would be released in the beginning of 2013-14. Non-recurring grant has already been provided to the State.

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- [v] **As approved by PAB** recurring grants to 2 SAAs already being supported under ICPS, has been provided as per ICPS norms for complete year based on the number of children in these SAA. (List A)
- [vi] **PAB approved** maintenance grant for the complete financial year for 14 Government run Homes (3 Children's Home, 10 Observation Home and 1 Special Homes) as per ICPS norms which were earlier getting grant under ICPS on the basis of average number of children. (List B)
- PAB approved grants for 12 NGO run Homes (5 for Girls and 7 for boys) for 6 months, of which two months' grant (i.e. for February and March 2013) will be released in the current year, and remaining four months' in the beginning of next financial year subject to the State confirming their registration under section 34 (3) of JJ Act.
- In principle approval was also granted for 10 more NGO Homes with a capacity of 50 children each subject to the State identifying space and NGOs for running these Homes.
- [vii] PAB approved the entire non-recurring and recurring grant for 6 months for 11 Open Shelters as per ICPS norms of which, in the current year, grant will be released only for 2 months. The balance grant would be released in the beginning of the next financial year. (List C)
- [viii] There are 38 **existing** Child Welfare Committees (CWCs). As **approved by PAB**, recurring grant for 33 functional CWCs for **complete year** except for salary of Data Entry operator. However, the State Govt. has informed that 1 CWC at Lakhi Sarai has been notified but members have not been appointed. Therefore, no grant is being released for CWC at Lakhi Sarai. The State has informed that the number of CWC sittings varies from 1 to 4 per week. The meeting allowance/honorarium of the Chairperson and members of the CWCs has been calculated on the basis of number of sittings.
- [ix] There are 38 **existing** Juvenile Justice Boards (JJBs). As **approved by PAB**, recurring grant for 38 functional JJBs for **complete year** except for salary of Data Entry operator. The State has informed that number of JJB sittings varies from 2 to 6 per week. The meeting allowance/honorarium of the Chairperson and members of the JJBs has been calculated on the basis of number of sittings as provided by the State Government.
- [x] The Government of Bihar shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary Statement of Expenditure in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2012-13.
- [xi] It is certified that Rule 209(6) (iii) of GFR, have kept in view at the time of releasing Grant to the State Govt'.
