- [i] **PAB approved recurring grant for State Project Support Unit [SPSU] for 3 months of the current financial year w.e.f. January, 2013. Since, the State Govt. has not utilized the amount released as first installment of 2012-13, no grant is being released under this component.**
- [ii] **PAB approved recurring grant for State Child Protection Society [SCPS] for 12 months of the current financial year w.e.f. April, 2012 except for staff salary, which has been approved as per date of appointment. Non-recurring grant for SCPS has already been provided to the State Government during previous financial year. Since the State Govt. has utilized the entire amount released as first installment, 2<sup>nd</sup> installment for 2012-13 is being released under this component.**
- [iii] **PAB approved recurring grant according to the staff appointment i.e. for 11 months in 11 DCPUs, 10 months in 6 DCPUs and 9 months in remaining 13 DCPUs except fund for Repatriating children, Sponsorship, Foster Care Fund and After Care for complete year in all Districts as these funds are child related. Non-recurring grant for all DCPUs have already been provided to the State Government. Since the State Govt. has utilized the entire amount released as first installment, 2<sup>nd</sup> installment for 2012-13 is being released under this component.**

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- [iv] PAB approved recurring grant for State Adoption Resource Agency [SARA] for 12 months of the current financial year w.e.f. 01.04.2012 to 31.03.2013. Since the State Govt. has utilized the entire amount released as first installment, 2<sup>nd</sup> installment for 2012-13 is being released under this component.
- [vi] PAB approved recurring grant for Six (6) Government run SAAs and Sixteen (16) NGO run SAAs for 12 months of the current financial year. Non-recurring grant for has already been provided to the State Government during previous financial year. Since the State Govt. has utilized the entire amount released as first installment, 2<sup>nd</sup> installment for 2012-13 is being released under this component. (List A)
- [vii] PAB approved maintenance grants to 47 Government run Homes [43 Children's Homes and 4 Observation Homes, and 10 NGO run Homes (9 Children's Homes and 1 Special Home)]. The maintenance grants under ICPS to the State Government for these Homes have been provided as per the norms and sharing pattern of the ICPS in this financial year. Further, PAB approved 5 additional Children's Homes and & 7 additional Observation Homes from date of sanction. Since the State Govt. has utilized the entire amount released as first installment, 2<sup>nd</sup> installment for 2012-13 is being released under this component. (List B)
- [viii] PAB approved grants for 9 Open Shelters (in addition to 14 for which grants have already been released this year) as requested by the State. The eligible grant for Open Shelters has been calculated as per the requirement projected by the State and ICPS norms whichever is less. PAB accorded in principle approval for one (1) new Open Shelter run by YMCA, subject to the State confirming approval of PSC. Non-recurring grants has already been released to State Govt. during previous year. The Second installment includes maintenance grant for 23 Open Shelters for which grant has been released during 2012-13 as first installment. Since the State Govt. has utilized the entire amount released as first installment, 2<sup>nd</sup> installment for 2012-13 is being released under this component. (List C)
- [ix] The recurring grants for 31 existing Child Welfare Committees [CWCs] have been provided for complete year. As per the information provided by the State Government, the total number of sittings in CWCs per month varies from 1 to 8. The calculations have been carried out for each CWC as per the number of meetings indicated against them. Since the State Govt. has utilized the entire amount released as first installment, 2<sup>nd</sup> installment for 2012-13 is being released under this component.

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- [x] The State has requested for recurring grant for 30 Juvenile Justice Boards (JJBs) for the complete financial year. However, the State has informed that JJB at Tumkur District is not functioning. The State has informed that Assistant cum Data entry Operator has been appointed in all JJBs. The State has informed that the total number of sittings in JJBs per month varies from 1 to 8. **The calculations have been carried out for each JJB as per the number of meetings indicated against them.** Rent has been provided for 5 JJBs only as requested by the State. **As approved by PAB, recurring grants have been provided for complete year for these 29 functional JJBs.** Since the State Govt. has **utilized the entire amount released as first installment, 2<sup>nd</sup> installment for 2012-13 is being released under this component.**
- [x] The Government of Karnataka shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary Statement of Expenditure in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2012-13.
- [xi] It is certified that Rule 209(6) (iii) of GFR, have kept in view at the time of releasing Grant to the State Govt'.

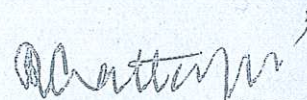
